All young people are entitled to have a chaperone present for any consultation, examination, treatment or procedure. You may ask for a chaperone at any time for any of the above.



Please let staff know if you would like a chaperone and they will arrange for a member of staff, or if appropriate, a family member or carer to be present during your consultation, examination, treatment or procedure.



Your healthcare professional may also require a chaperone to be present for certain consultations in accordance with our Chaperone Policy.
